- 2. Eligible candidates must apply online only after reading the instructions given here below thoroughly and carefully after checking the eligibility criteria given above before submitting the online application.
- 3. Important dates for Online Application:
 - a. Starting date for Online Registration: 12th September, 2024.
 - b. Last date of Online Registration: 24th September, 2024.
 - c. Last date of Submission of application fees online: 27th September, 2024.
 - d. Last date of Full Submission of Online application form: 1st October, 2024.

N.B.: Online Registration is mandatory for all online applications.

- 7. The following self-attested photocopies of the essential documents are to be also submitted though Speed post/Registered post:
