RECRUITMENT OF BOAT CREW STAFF IN INDIAN NAVY

Indian Navy invites applications for the posts of Boat Crew Staff classified as Group 'C', Non-Gazetted, Non-Industrial from eligible candidates to apply online through Indian Navy website [www.joinindiannavy.gov.in](http://joinindiannavy.gov.in) for the posts of Syring of Lescares, Lascars, Fireman & Topasse. Selected candidates normally will serve in the units under administrative control of Headquarters, Western Naval Command, Mumbai. They can however be posted anywhere in India, at Naval units formations as per administrative requirement. The vacancy details are as follows:

Physical requirement suitability for PadDDs - As per posts identified by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment notification No. 30-12/2020-CO-II dated 04 Jan 2021 amended-via notification No. 30-12/2020-CO-II dated 24 Aug 2022, the PadDD candidates belonging to following suitable categories of benchmark disability may apply for above posts accordingly:-

Persons with SLD with associated MR dysfunction shall be covered under the respective sub category such as G1, G2 etc. as the case may be.

Note: PadDD candidates must be in possession of disability certificate issued by the Competent Authority prior to applying Online, in the prescribed format as mentioned at Rule 16(1) of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Notification G.S.R.391(E) dated 18 Jun 2017. Abbreviations used: UR- Unreserved, SC- Scheduled Caste, ST- Scheduled Tribe, OBC- Other Backward Class, EWS - Economic Weaker Section, PadDD- Persons with Benchmark Disabilities, ESM - Ex-Servicemen, VH- Visually Handicapped, HH- Hearing Handicapped, OH- Orthopaedic Handicapped, OL- One Leg, OA- One Arm, SH- Spinal Deficiency, SI- Spinal Injury, LV- Low Vision, D- Dual, CP- Cerebral Palsy, G- Leg/Arm Curved, DW- Dwarfism, AAC- Acid Attack Victims, ASD (M, MoD)- Autism Spectrum Disorder (M- Mild, MoD- Moderate), SLD- Specific Learning Disability, MI- Mental illness, MD- Multiple Disabilities, S- Seizing, ST- Stereotyped, W- Walking, BN- Sitting, MP- Manipulation with Fingers, SE- Seizing, C- Communication.

Reservation: Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/EWS categories are available as per Govt. Government Orders. The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible ICAs, STs, OBCs, EWS candidates which will thus comprise of SC, ST, OBC, EWS who are either lower in merit than the last candidate on merit list of UR category or SC/ST/OBC candidates who have availed age relaxation for respective category irrespective of their position in merit list. Similarly, reserved vacancies for PadDDs, ESM & Ex-Agrimars will be filled up from amongst such eligible candidates of respective category who are lower in merit than the last candidate on merit list of respective category but otherwise found suitable for the appointment even

by relaxed standard. Reservations for PadDDs, ESM & Ex-Agrimars fall under the category of horizontal reservation which cuts across vertical reservation i.e. reservation for SC/ST/OBC/EWS (which is called inter-casting reservation).

The candidates selected against the PadDDs, ESM & Ex-Agrimars quota will be placed in the appropriate category of SC/ST/OBC/EWS as the case may be.

4. Essential Qualification

(d)	Topasse	(a) 10th pass from a recognised Institute or Board. (b) Knowledge of swimming.

Note: (a) Syring certificate granted under Indian Vessel's Act, 1917 will also be accepted as Indian Vessel's Act, 1917 has been superseded by Indian Vessel's Act, 2001.

(b) The experience gained for the posts of Syring of Lescares and Lascars-I need to be obtained on a vessel registered under Merchant Shipping Act, 1952 or Indian Vessel's Act, 1917/2001 with a valid "Certification of Survey". If the vessel is a fishing vessel, the vessel is to be registered and licensed as per the Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1978 or under any of the Fishing Regulation Act of State/Ter.

(c) For the post of Fireman, the certificate of having completed pre-sea training course is required to be I.C.A. Director General of Shipping (DG) Circular No. 18 of 2020 dated 24 Apr 2020 and 20 of 2020 dated 27 May 2020. The format for course completion certificate shall be as per that mentioned at DG's Circular 20 of 2020. For certificates awarded prior to 21-01-2020, the certificate of having completed pre-sea training course is to be I.C.A. DG Circulars issued from time to time for that relevant period. The name and logo of the Maritime Training Institute (MTI) is to be clearly mentioned at the top of the certificate along with the MTI No. and Certificate No. The MTI is required to have been registered and approved by Director General of Shipping during the period the pre-sea training course was undertaken. The candidates are required to submit the following attachments:-

(i) Attachment 1 - Copy of the pre-sea course completion certificate (Degree/Diploma course certificate)

(ii) Attachment 2 - Copy of the certificate for successful assessment of MTI book Codet record book of the approved shipboard training

(d) All supporting documents necessary to prove experience and essential qualifications are required to be submitted at the time of filing online application. The same shall be verified at the time of document verification/pre-appointment formalities and thereafter Indian Navy reserves the right to issue provisional Offer of Appointment only after vetting, scrutiny or / and completion of verification of all supporting documents with relevant authorities.
